Sal also stated that he had been going around to Town buildings that aren't accessible and asking the owners to make them handicapped accessible. He has the Delta Building putting in a ramp now as he spoke to the owner about regulations and codes. He also is bringing Michelle Duprey in on the GNH Transit Board as she is an advocate for the disabled. The Urban Renewal Commission told Sal that if the ADA gets a request for a residential handicapped accessibility project they would consider putting it under the Small Cities Grant and use the funds they have. The resident would have to qualify just as the applicants on the program, but it could be helpful if someone needs help making their homes accessible.
