**DIRECTOR'S REPORT**

Director DeSorbo stated that he has made numerous attempts to contact the owner of the old Eblens plaza. He has not responded to any form of communication. Director DeSorbo stated he would be taking a ride to meet with him in Norwalk regarding unifying both plazas, which will only help the owner. Director DeSorbo can commit to the cost of an Engineer but the Town won't pay for construction. It will be to make it easier for residents to go between both plazas rather than having to go out on Rte. 80. Shop Rite is working feverishly to get everything finished by Labor Day. Commissioner Pacelli stated he had gone to Hobby Lobby and it is very large and very busy. With regard to the Town Fair Tire update, Director DeSorbo was supposed to go Monday to the Army Corps of Engineers but the meeting was rescheduled to a later date. He has already met with the DEEP a few weeks ago. Director DeSorbo stated that there will be a bench dedicated to Joe Buonome on the green in a few weeks. The beach is complete and looks very nice. Public Works did a nice job with the sand. There is no reimbursement from the State for sand. There is also a nice seawall in front of Victoria Beach condos. Director DeSorbo stated that there has been discussion of possible speed bumps on Cosey Beach and 2<sup>nd</sup> Avenue during the summer or closure of the street seasonally but nothing has come to fruition.
