Directions to the East Haven Fire Department • Station 3 • 1480 North High Street (at Route 80)

91-South: Take I-91 South to Exit #8. At the bottom of the exit ramp, turn Left onto Route 80. Go straight to the 10th traffic light (tenth is a blinking traffic light in front of the fire station on the right).

91-North: Take I-91 North to Exit #8. Bear Right off the exit ramp onto Route 80. Go straight to the 9th traffic light (the ninth light is a blinking traffic light in front of the fire station on the right).

95-North: To I-91 North and follow 91 North above.

95-South: To exit 52. At bottom of exit ramp, turn Right onto Route 100. Go approximately 3 miles (past IGA and a gas station on right). Go past 1st stop sign, fire station will be several hundred feet on the left before you reach route 80.
