Mr. Jim Pretti, architect, stated the site is 6.3 acres and drains into a culvert. The State DEEP is requiring a flood plain management application. The increase would be negligible and they are asking for outlet protection for the 40 inch culvert. Mr. Staunton stated that this is the last hurdle for this building project, and he recommended it be approved. Mrs. Brow made a motion to approve, seconded by Sean O'Brien. A roll call vote was taken, Mrs. Armour-yes, Mrs. Brow-yes, Mrs. Esposito-yes, Mr. O'Brien-yes. All in favor, motion carries.
