

**EAST HAVEN BOARD OF POLICE COMMISSIONERS
MINUTES—SPECIAL MEETING JULY 19, 2010

Meeting called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Chairman Frederick Brow

Roll Call:

Pledge of Allegiance/Moment of Silence

Commissioners Present: Chairman Frederick Brow, Vice-Chairman Joseph Civitello, Commissioner James Krebs. Commissioner Saddig and Piergrossi were absent.

Also Present: Acting Chief Gaetano J. Nappi, Attorney Patricia Cofrancesco, Detective Robert Ranfone Vice President Local 1662 and Ed Foley Video Recorder.

Agenda:

1. Discussion/action regarding sending the Civil Service Commission a letter requesting that Civil Service start the testing for the position of Captain and Lieutenant at the East Haven Police Department.

A motion was made by Commissioner Krebs to send a letter to the Civil Service Commission requesting they start testing for the position of Captain and Lieutenant at the East Haven Police Department, seconded by Vice-Chairman Civitello. All in favor. Motion carried.

Commissioner Krebs asked how long the process would take. Chief Nappi explained that the application process would take about 3 weeks, they would be given 45 days to study and then have the test. It would probably take around 2 ½ months.

2. Discussion/action regarding putting up Stop Signs at the following locations:
 - a. The end of Sunset Road which intersects with Borrman Road
 - b. The end of Clancy Street which intersects with Borrman Road
 - c. The end of Willow Road which intersects with Borrman Road
 - d. Old Foxon Road and Rose Street

A motion was made by Vice-Chairman Civitello that various signs be put up at the end of Sunset Road which intersects with Borrman Road, the end of Clancy Street which intersects with Borrman Road, the end of Willow Road which intersects with Borrman Road and Old Foxon Road and Rose Street, seconded by Commissioner Krebs. All in favor. Motion carried.

Chairman Brow commented that he and the Chief went to the various locations and found that the signs had disappeared . Regarding Old Foxon and Rose Street, there has never been a sign there.

3.Discussion/action regarding erecting Two Speed Signs in the area of 222 Grannis Street.

A motion was made by Commissioner Krebs to erect two Speed Signs in the area of 222 Grannis Street, seconded by Vice-Chairman Civitello. All in favor. Motion carried

Chief Nappi explained that they would be the standard 25 miles per hour signs at the curve.

A motion was made by Chairman Brow to adjourn meeting, seconded by Vice-Chairman Civitello. All in favor. Motion carried.

Chairman Brow adjourned meeting at 7:05 p.m.
