The East Haven Recreation and Athletic Complex Commission held a regular meeting on Monday, April 12, 2010 at the East Haven Senior Center.

CALL TO ORDER: The meeting was called to order at 7:36 P.M.

ROLL CALL:

APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

Motion was made by Commissioner Marsico and seconded by Commissioner Rispoli to approve the minutes from the March 8, 2010 meeting.

Motion was made by Commissioner Marsico and seconded by Commissioner Rispoli to open Public Session.

Torrey Morse, Victoria Manfredi and Rev. Gilbert Wilkes of the Christ Anglican Church requested use of the East Haven Town Green on Thursday, May 5, 2010, from 6:00 p.m. to 8:00 for a ceremony sponsoring the National Day of Prayer. This date will be commemorated nationwide, and a Proclamation has been signed by Gov. Rell. All clergy,

denominations, municipal agencies, police and fire departments will be invited. All will be welcome to this event.

Motion was made by Chairman Pacelli and seconded by Commissioner Marsico to approve the Christ Anglican Church's request to use the Town Green on Thursday, May 5, 2010 from 6:00 p.m. to 8:30 p.m., for the Day of Prayer, with the stipulation that clean up is done afterward.

DIRECTOR'S REPORT:

Louis Pane, Director of Recreation reported on activities at the Athletic Complex. Skating season is now officially over and the ice has been taken up. The pool is now using Spring/Summer hours and opens at 8:00 a.m. St. Mary's School will begin using the pool three times a week at \$175/day, providing additional \$2500-\$2700 in revenue to the town. The Easter Egg Hunt, funded mainly by the Recreation Department, was very successful. Donations were received from Automated Services and Wendy's. Summer yoga begins the first Saturday in May, there is no cost but a donation of a canned good is requested. The Town Beach will open Memorial Day and remain open until Labor Day.
