**3. Discussion of Portable Classroom Project – Selection of Architect:**

**Mr. Luciano handed out a proposal from Silver Petrucelli Architects and Capitol  
Studio Architects.**

**Mr. Luciano reported that he spoke to the Town Engineer regarding the Overbrook School site and the area is listed as a poorly drained site. A permit may be required before we proceed, but we can look into getting it waived. A soil scientist would need to write a report indicating that the addition of the portable classrooms would present no impact. Mr. Luciano also had some concerns about surveys being included in the proposals and the Town Council would have to have a public hearing on this project.**
