Elderly Outreach

- ◆ Provides services to frail and home bound residents.
- ◆ "Lighthouse Keeping & Company" a program to assist the frail elderly with light housekeeping. Qualified residents must be at least 60 years old with limited activities of daily life.
- ◆ Family contacts and caregivers support provided.
- ◆ Home-site visits.
- ◆ Referrals to senior housing, nursing home facilities, and assisted living and congregate housing sites.
- ◆ Information on home health agencies.
- ◆ Assistance with forms and applications.
