❖ **Connecticut Energy Assistance Program**

The Connecticut Energy Assistance Program (CEAP) is designed to help offset the winter heating costs of Connecticut's lower income households. Benefits in the CEAP vary to reflect need, cost, or energy burden. The Program is designed to provide the highest level of assistance to those households who have the lowest incomes and highest energy needs in relation to income, taking into account household size and vulnerability.

The program period is October 1st – April 15th.

❖ **Renter's Rebate Program**

Available to Connecticut renters who are 65 years of age or older or receiving Social Security Disability benefits whose incomes do not exceed certain limits. Must be a Connecticut resident for one year and have rented in 2015.

Application period is May 15th through September 15th.
