Public comment:

- Donna Richo-67 Charnes Drive, East Haven- Mrs. Richo asks what roof repair we are taking the \$56,000 from.
- Councilman Joseph Santino says it is from unspent 2017 capital funds.
- Mrs. Richo says she wants a capital funds report.

Council comment:

- Councilman Joseph Santino says the Ordinance should specify the repairs are for Station 4.
- Attorney Zullo indicates they can vote on that amendment when they vote to report to the full Town Council.
- Councilman Joseph Deko asks if the Chief can come up to explain what repairs are needed for the \$100,000.
- Fire Chief Matthew Marcarelli indicates he hasn't done a full scope of work yet but they will be repointing the brick, the brick mortar has deteriorated. If you go inside the building you will see areas where the drywall was affected by moisture migrating into the building. The largest portions of the funds will be spent on that. If there are monies left after that which he suspects there will be he will look into a maintenance free exterior and possibly bricking up the front portion of the living quarters that has a wood structure. He would like to give it a little more curb appeal for the neighborhood. Once the exterior money is spent he will try to migrate inside to improve the quality of life. Last year they had money for exterior repairs that were transferred to cover the cost of a federal grant he received so that job had to be postponed. The councilor in this district found the money for him to now do these repairs and the money will be well spent.
- Councilman Robert Parente says he knows they are in the process of finishing up the heat through the Honeywell project in there, have they noticed a difference in the heat?
- Chief Marcarelli says yes in the living quarters, they still have to work on the
 other boiler to heat up the hallway but it is noticeable. All of the fire houses they
 have noticed a difference; it has been a huge improvement for them. He thanks
 the outgoing Council members for their service to the Town and his Department
 and he looks forward to working with the Council members that will still be on the
 Council.
