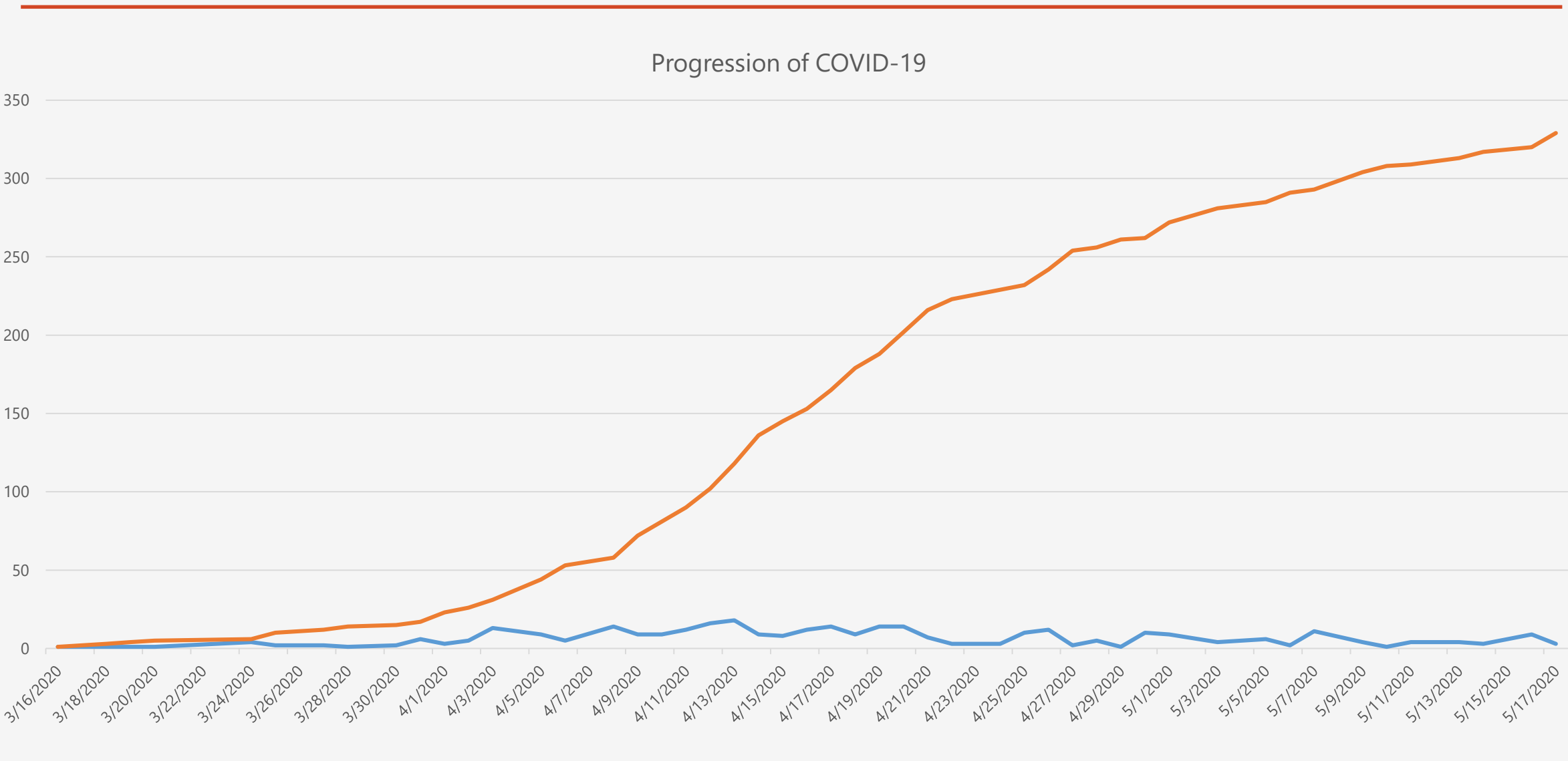

# East Haven COVID-19 Facts and Figures

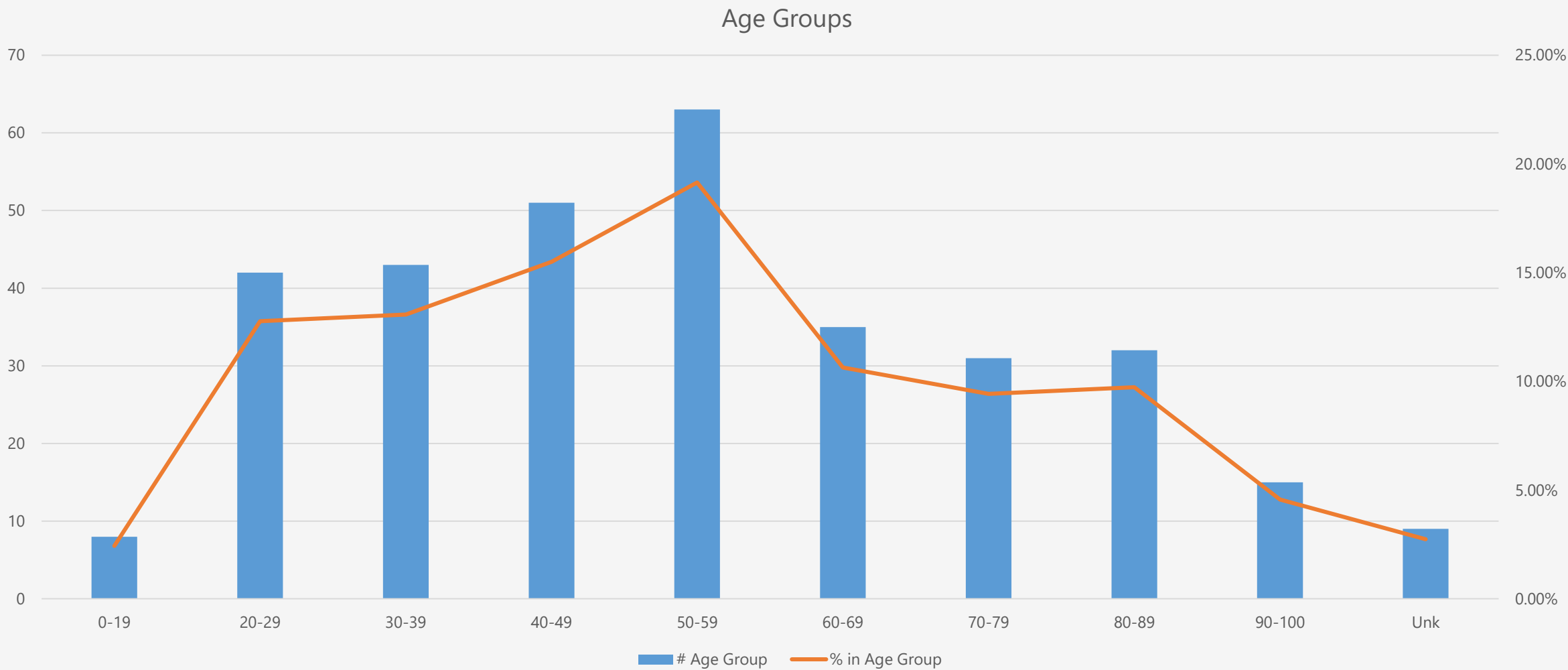
---

- Currently based on numbers between multiple sources there are 329 people positive for COVID-19. There have been 32 fatalities due to COVID-19 or complications related to COVID-19.
- State data on May 10 has East Haven at 361 cases but our numbers from multiple sources indicate 329, attributed to State Database Errors, Delay in Data, Incorrect Addresses. All charts are based on May 17 State data.
- Town Hall workers returned to work May 4<sup>th</sup>, Town Hall remains closed to the public.
- Town Administration is working on a plan for the Town Beach.

# Progression of Cases in East Haven Since March 16, 2020



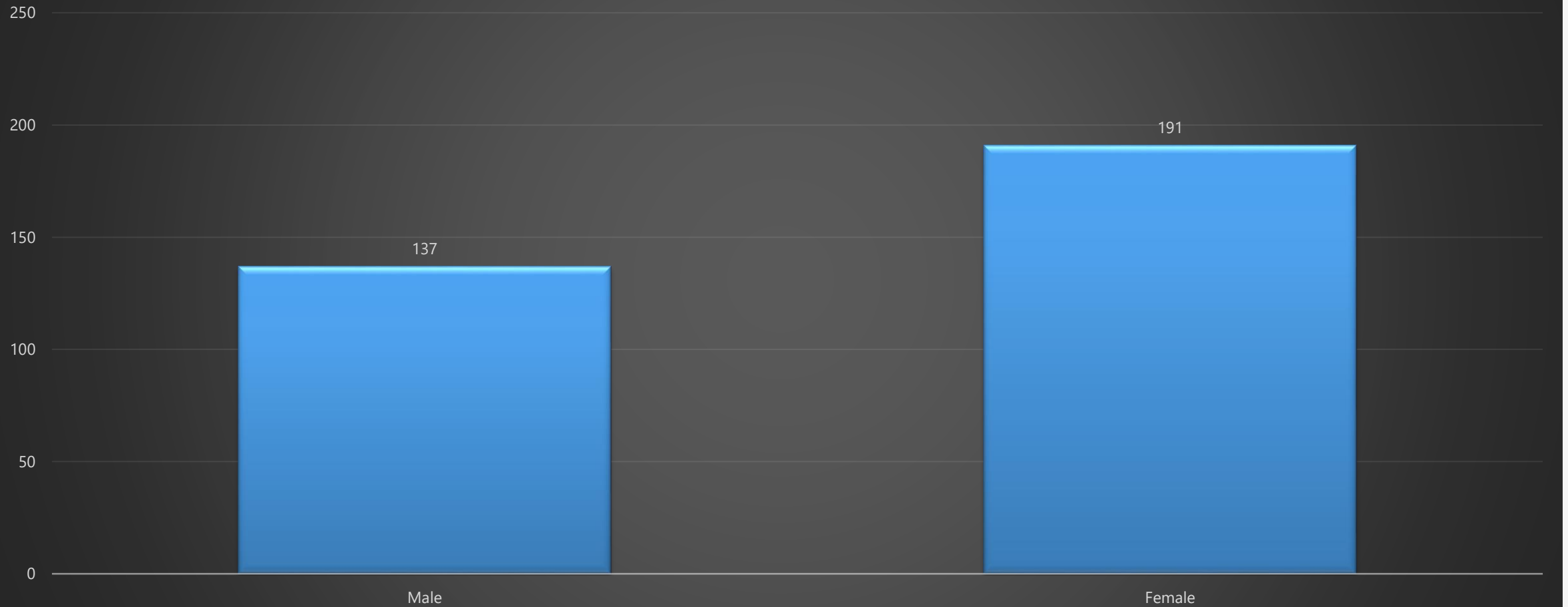

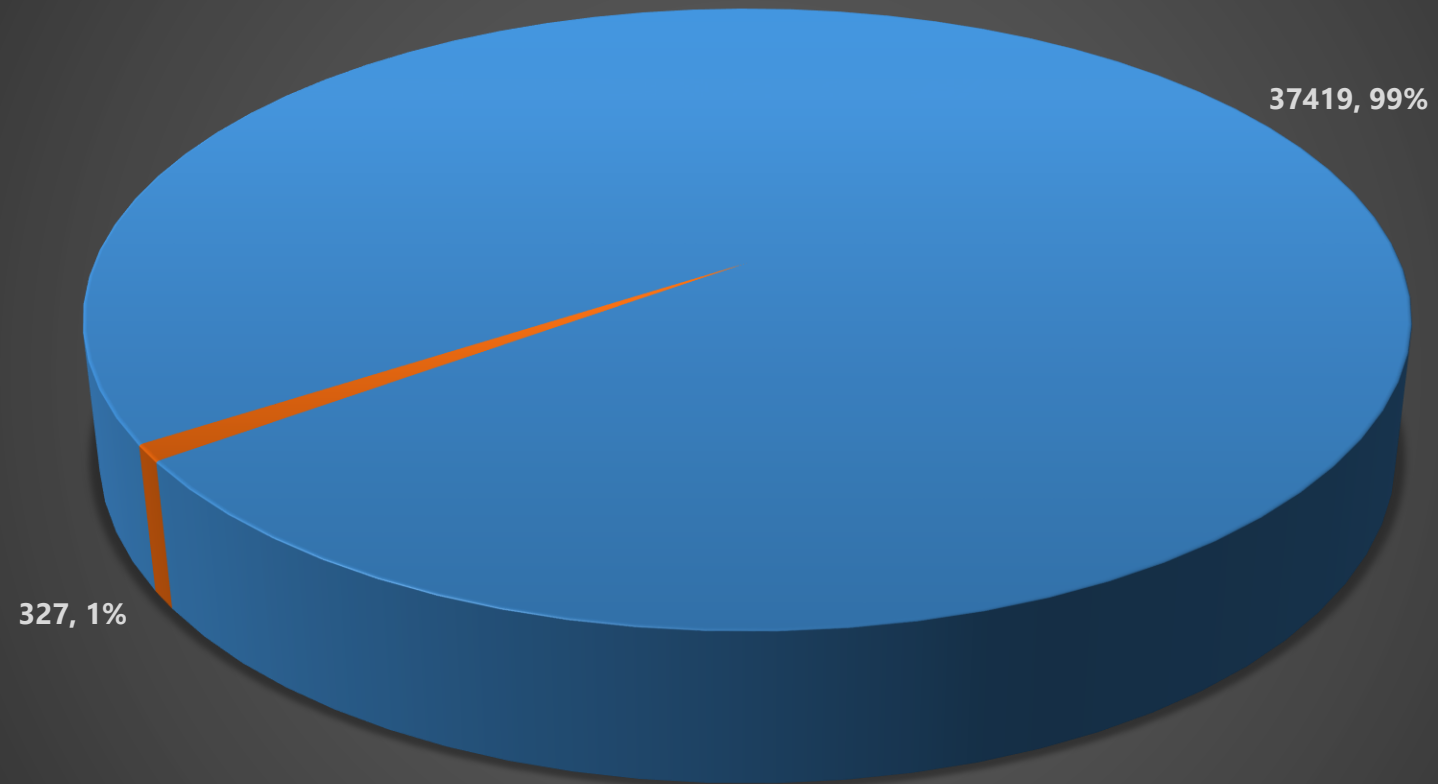
**Male VS. Female Infection**

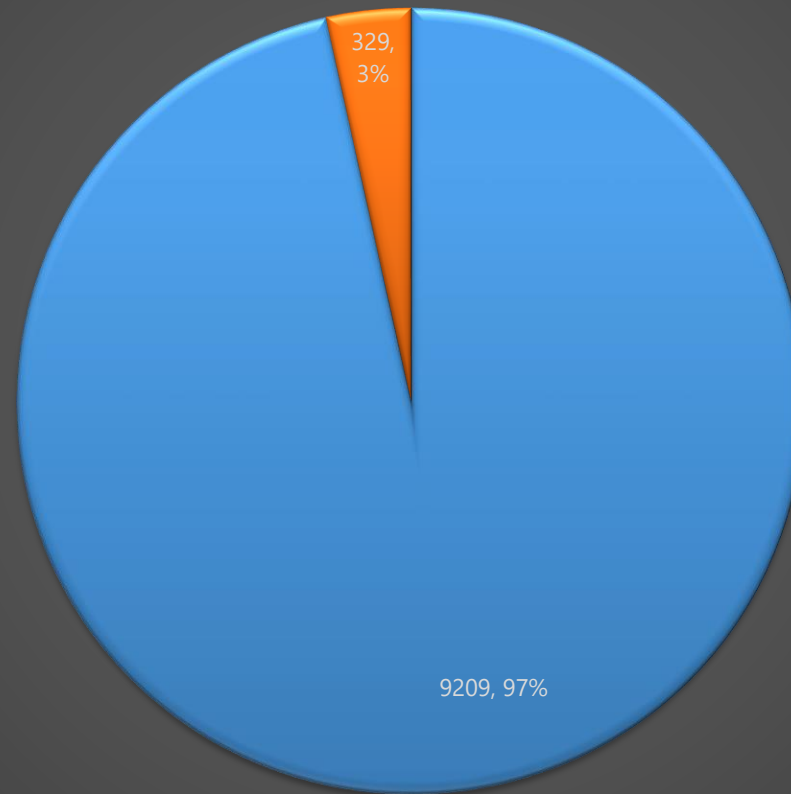
**Positive Cases East Haven vs. Connecticut**

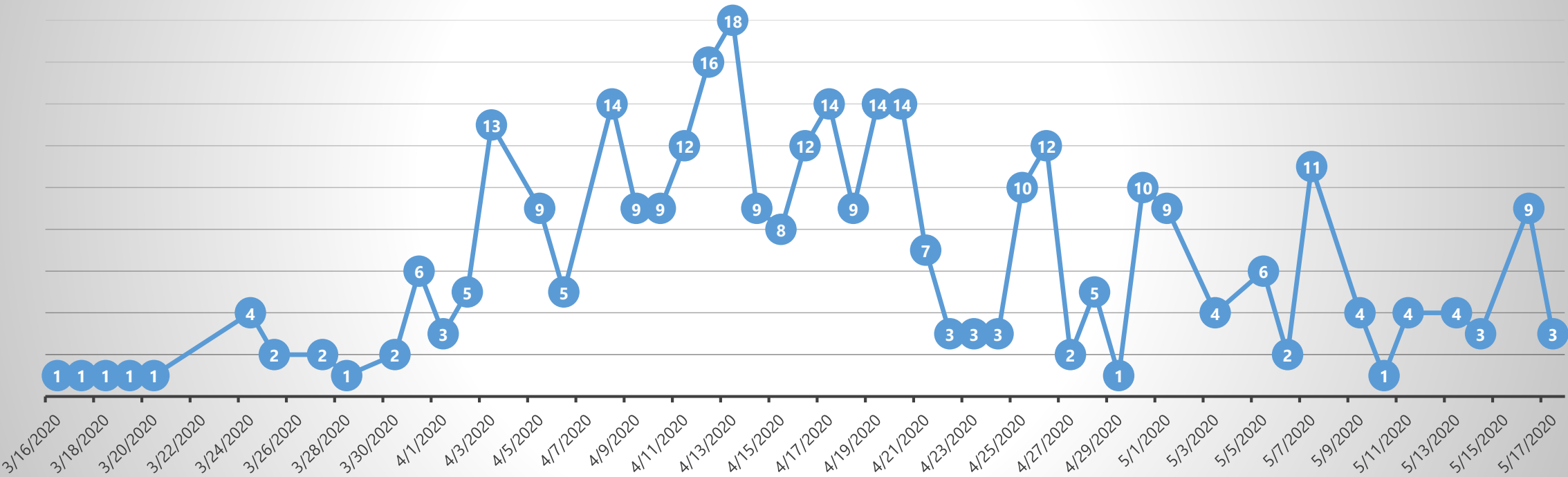

Cases Per Day

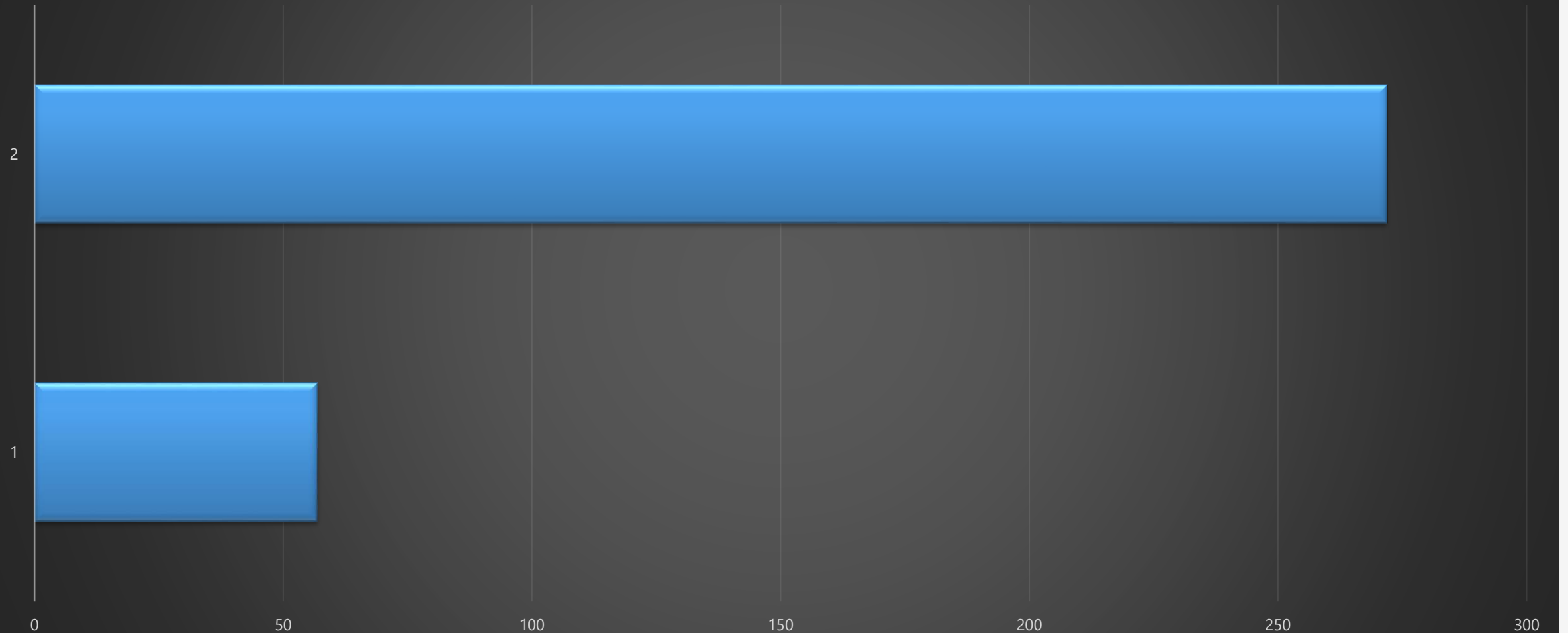
