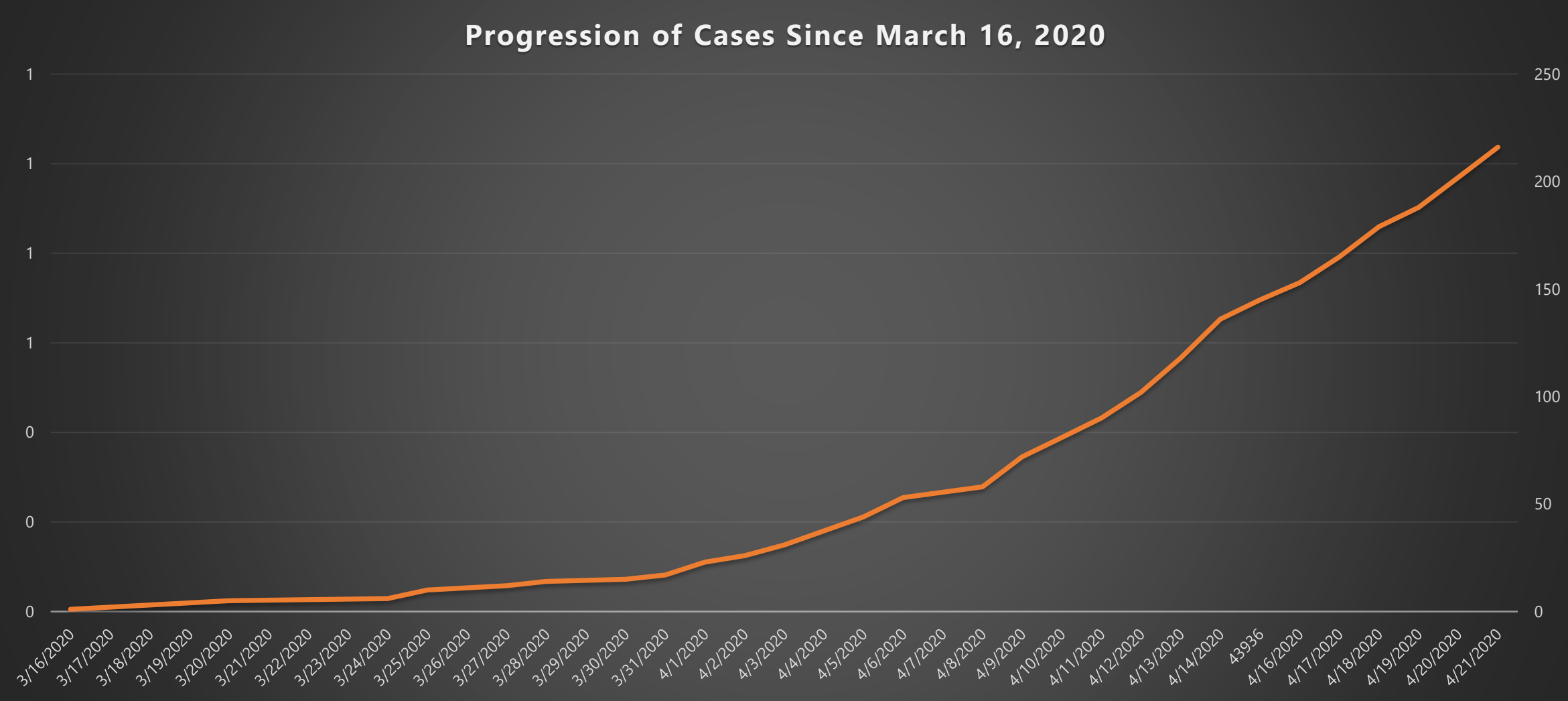

East Haven COVID-19 Facts and Figures

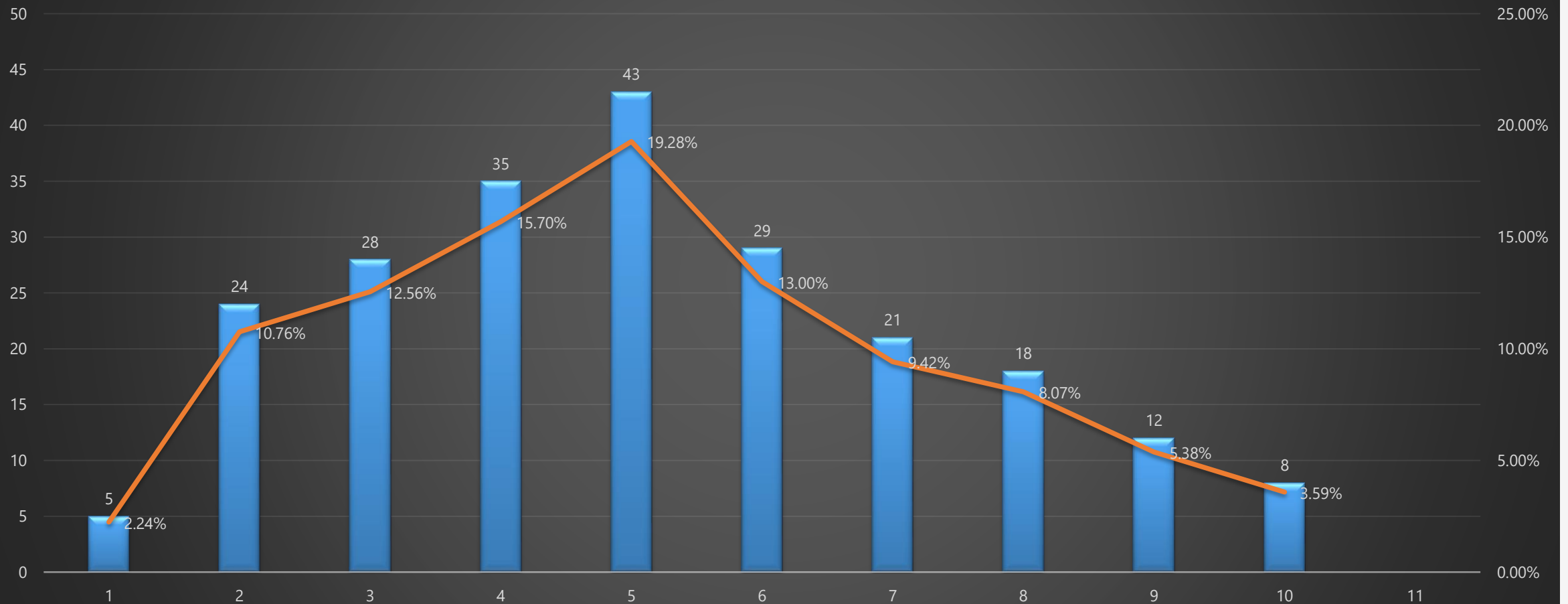
- Currently based on numbers between multiple sources there are 223 people positive for COVID-19. There have been 29 fatalities due to COVID-19 or complications related to COVID-19.
- Data is current as of 3:00 PM April 21, 2020
- Governor Lamont issued Executive Order 7BB Requiring Face Coverings in Public Effective Monday April 20, 2020 at 8:00 am. Postpones Presidential Primary to August 11.
- Today East Haven Fire Department will deliver 500 masks to Whispering Pines Staff and 500 Masks to Apple Rehab.

Progression of Cases in East Haven Since March 16, 2020



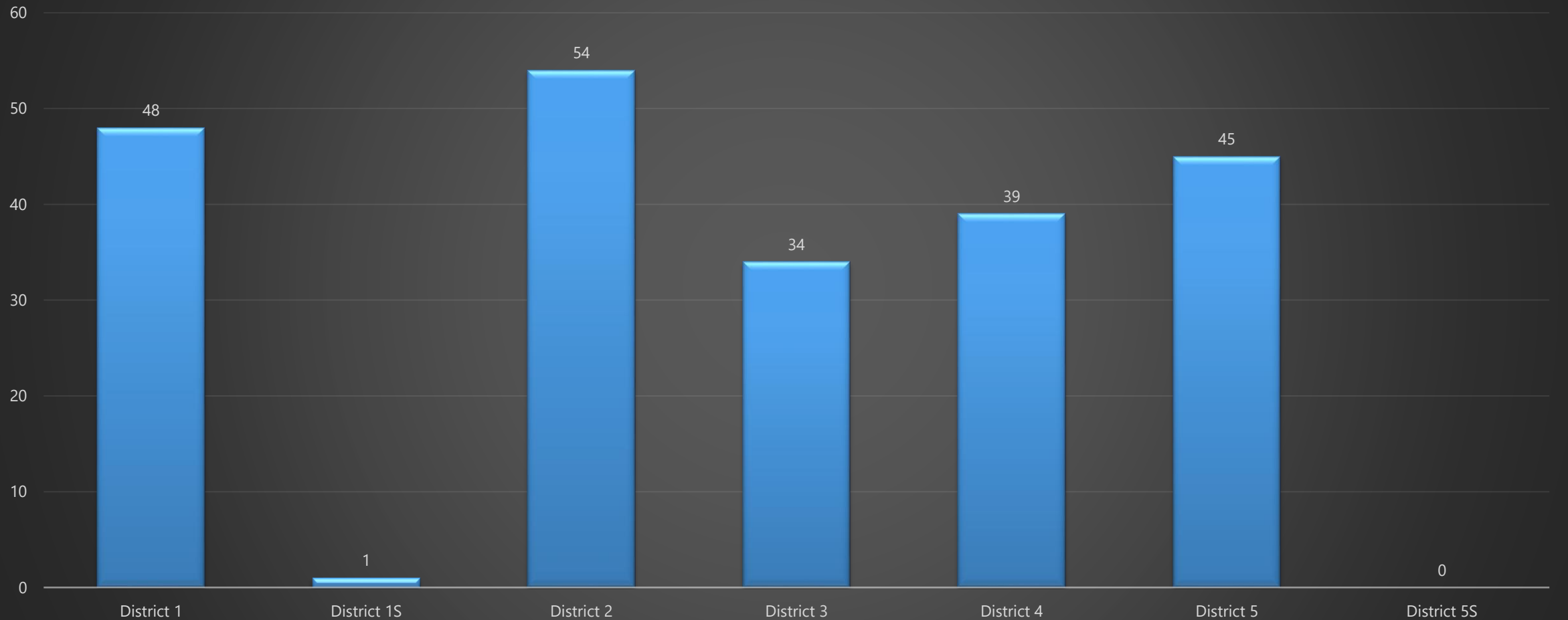
Case Numbers By Age Group

EH COVID-19 By Age Group



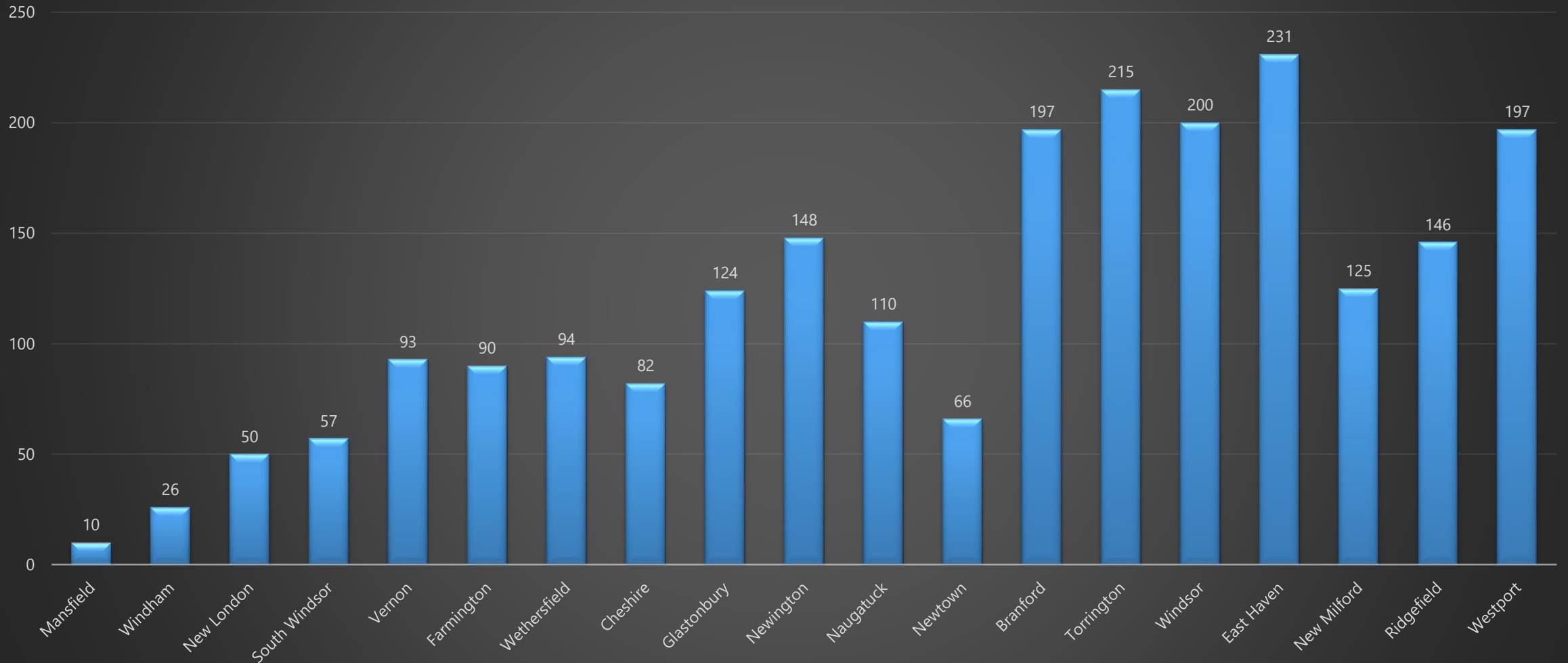
Where are Positive Cases in Town?

COVID-19 Distribution by District



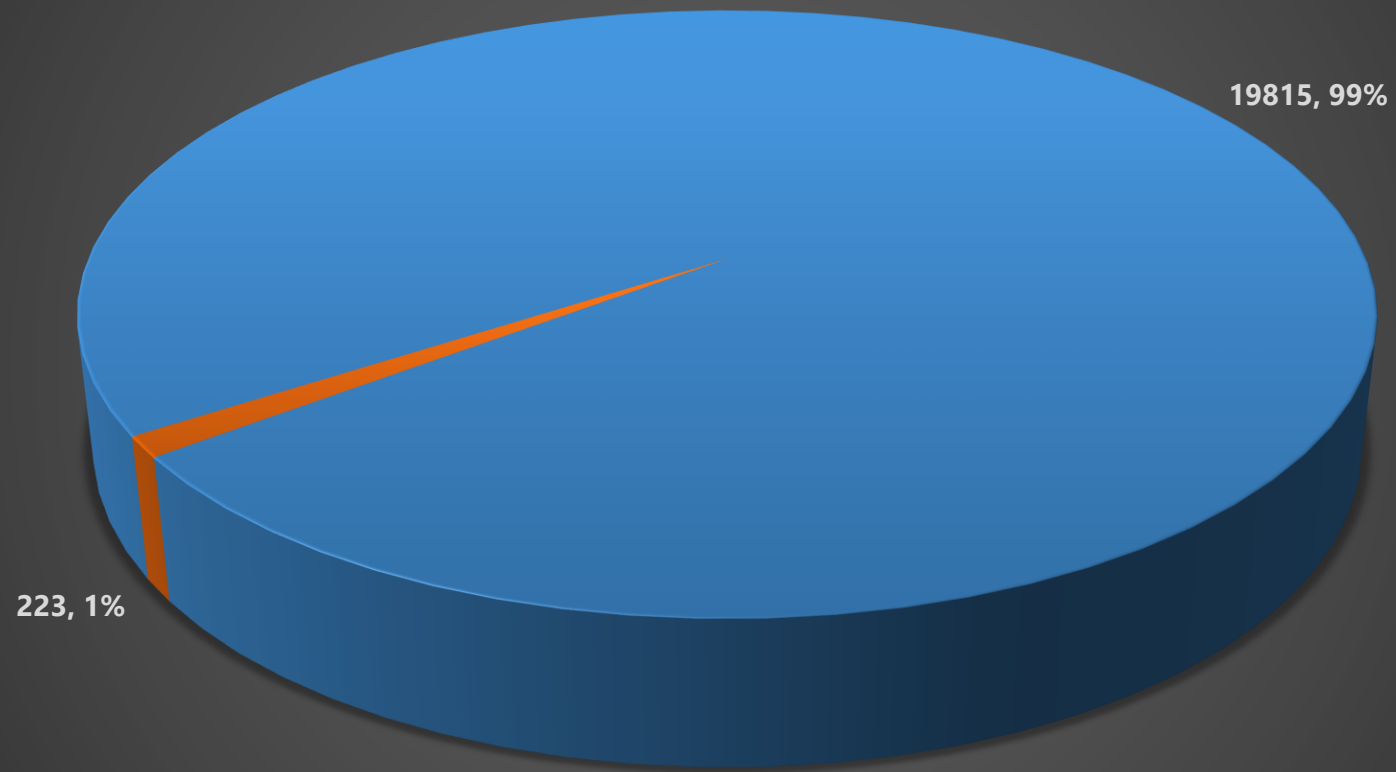
Comparison to Similar Sized Towns

Covid-19 Towns with population between 25,000-35,000



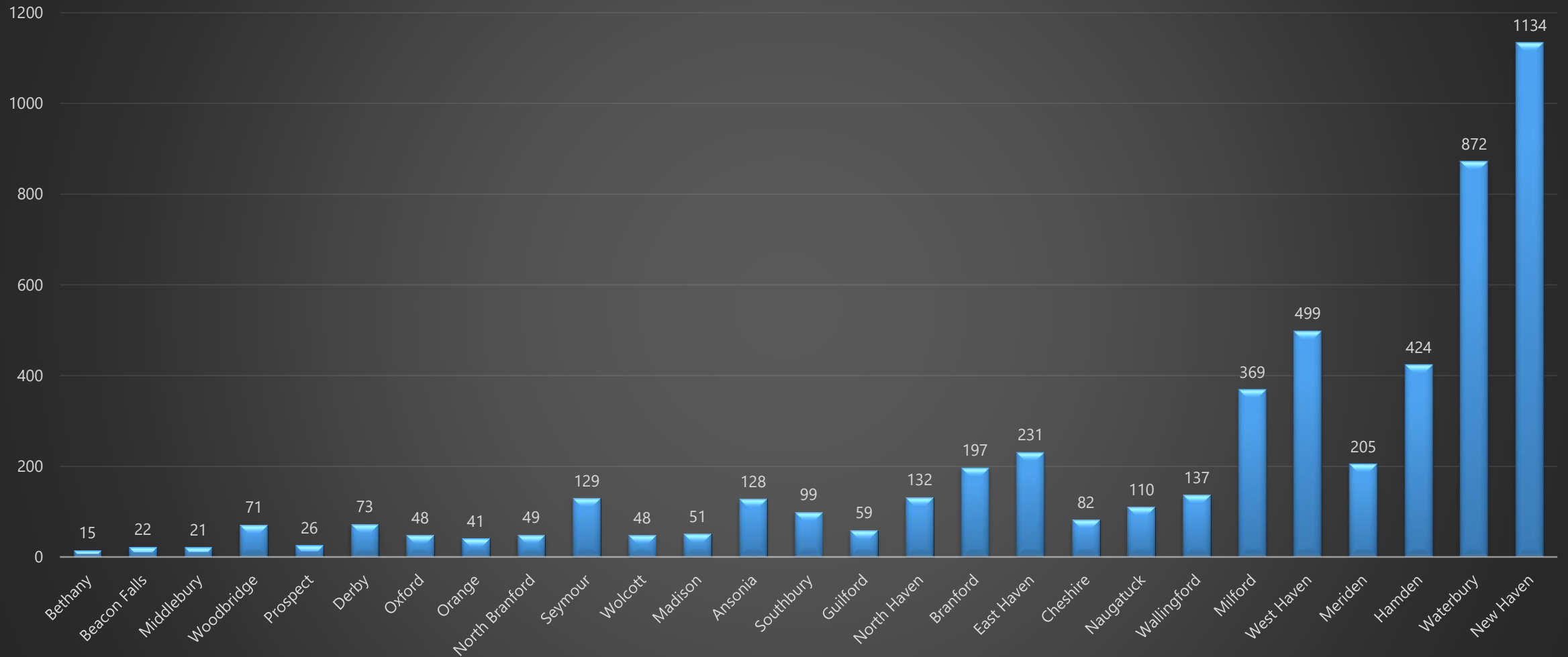
How Does East Haven Compare to Connecticut?

Positive Cases East Haven vs. Connecticut



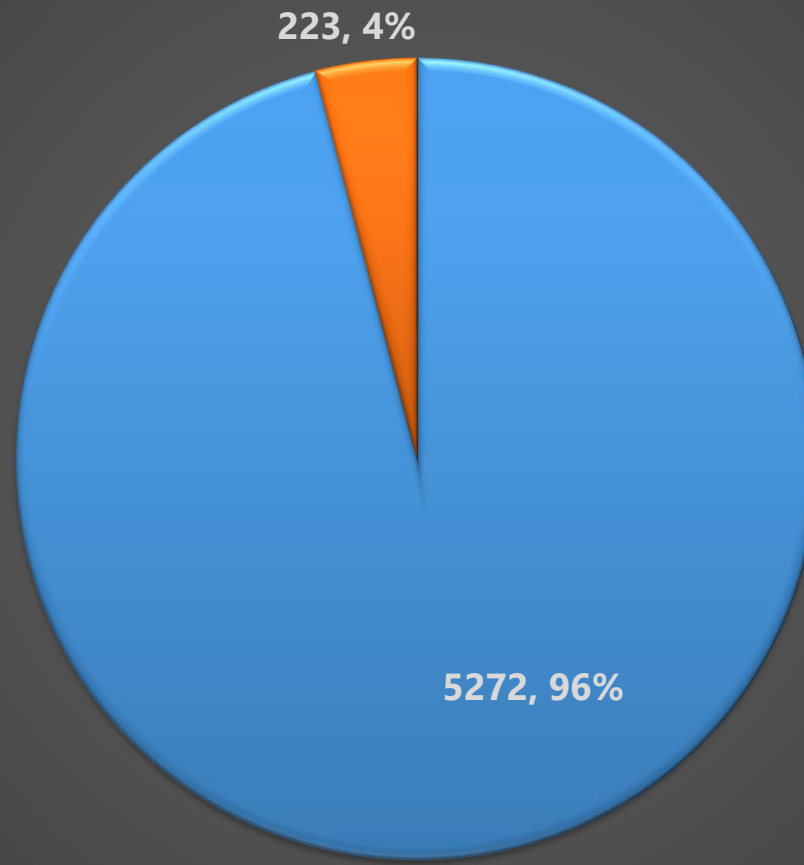
Where does East Haven Compare to New Haven County

COVID-19 New Haven County



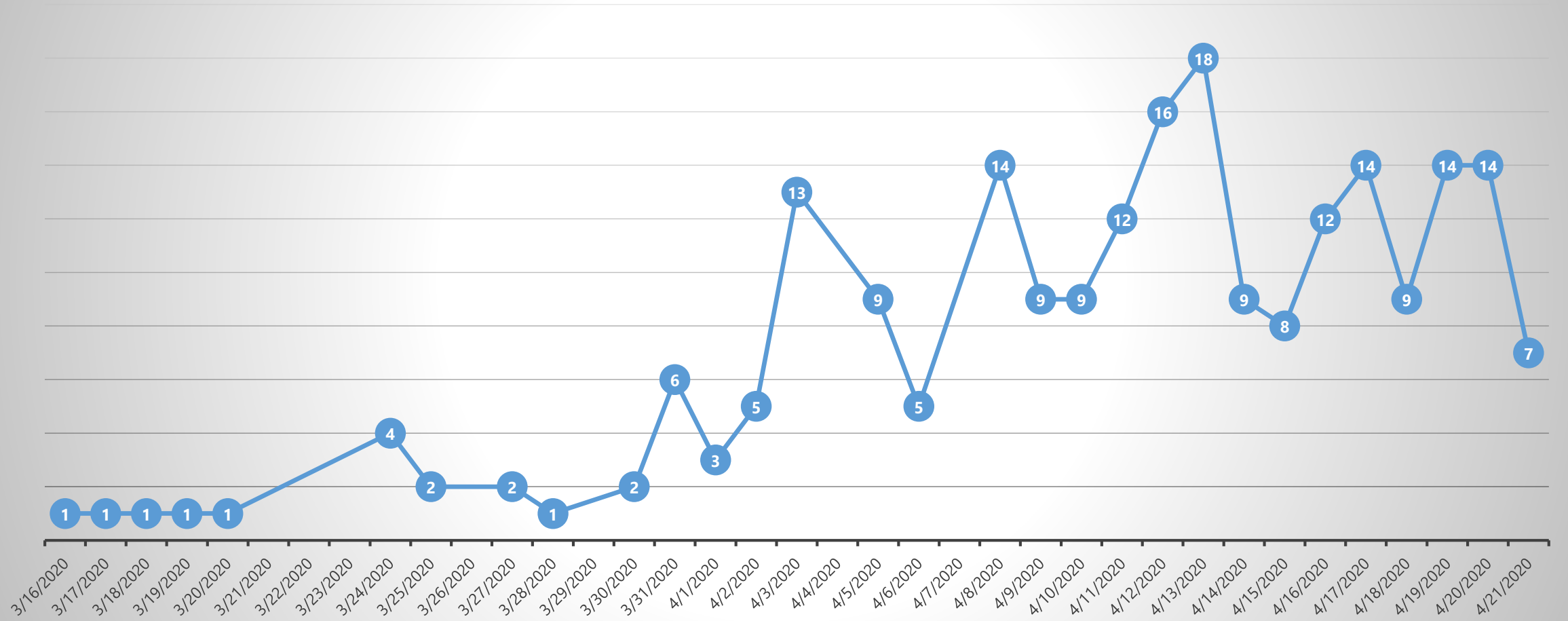
East Haven COVID-19 Positive in New Haven County
